forthcoming year.




QQ 188 Gertrude Street, Fitzroy.

We are unsure as to the building date of 188 but the very next shop was built in 1888 by F.M. White & Sons, Architects. "It will not be long before Gertrude Street is as architecturally imposing as so fine a thoroughfare should be.

At Christmas tide all the business streets of Fitzroy hummed but in both Gertrude Street and Smith Street the congestion was extreme, the paths on both sides being too narrow for the

An 1884 Christmas **Pudding Recipe**

Chop, or mince finely 1 lb beef suet or butter, rub into 1 lb plain flour add 1 lb currants, 1 lb raisins, 1|2 cup brandy, 1 lb sultanas, 1 lb sugar, 1|2 lb finely grated breadcrumbs, 1 teaspoon mixed spice, 1|2 teaspoon nutmeg, 1|4 lb peel cut finely, 1|4 lb blanched almonds, one teaspoon salt. Mix well together and moisten with 8 eggs well beaten. Dip cloth into boiling water fill with mixture and tie at top. Boil pudding in cloth for 7 to 8 hours. Hang until Christmas and boil for a further 3 hours on the day. Serve with sweet sauce, brandy sauce or boiled custard. Mrs. R.L. Whittacker.


